	move the IP to another host as 212.13.194.71 was provisioned back in the bad old days and a terrible	
	decision was made to not dedicate a service IP to it.	
	Some time in the next 6 months people need to start migrating to the new IP allocation (85.119.80.0/21) and all infrastructure needs to move first, so it might be an idea to provision the resolver service IP as one of the first IPs from that allocation. When the migration is complete in at least 6 months 212.13.194.71 can be retired.
